

- 120 campers were here with "HIS Kids" a camp that caters to children with cancer and their siblings
- 216 campers participated in Annie's Hope Camp, which serves children who have lost a loved one
- 34 children came from foster care programs
- 21% of the children we served this summer received some form of scholarship to attend Camp

We hope you will be blessed this evening with good food, good fun, good fellowship, and the knowledge that you are a blessing to the thousands of campers that visit Camp Wartburg each year.
