Among these campers are campers with disabilities, children affected by cancer, children from state foster care programs, and teens in Confirmation classes.... Nearly 35% of our campers receive some form of scholarship assistance. All church denominations are represented and welcome.

We serve 7,500 individuals throughout the year which includes children from over 50 schools – public and parochial and youth and adult retreat groups. Currently we have more than 120 day campers here every day along with our overnight campers. We plan to serve 250 day campers and 500+ overnight campers throughout this summer.
